

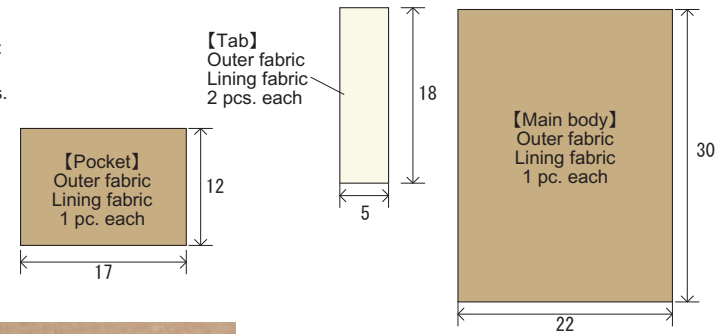

Embroidery Stitching Tool with 3-Ply Needle
 Needle Refill 1-Ply Needle
 Needle Refill Needle for Medium-Fine Yarn
 Clover Embroidery Hoop (7")
 Clover Glue For Embroidery Stitching Tool

Materials

Main body/Pocket (Outer fabric/Lining fabric):
 Cotton Duck (Beige) 61 x 30 cm...1 pc.
 Tab: Cotton Fabric (Beige) 18 x 5 cm...2 pcs.
 Adhesive interlining/white
 Lace Width 1.5 x 17 cm...1 pc.
 Buttons Dia. 1.5 cm...2 pcs.
 Ribbon
 Embroidery threads: 1 skein each



Full-size embroidery pattern

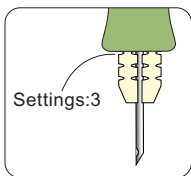


- d... 1-Ply Needle/Settings:3/Satin Stitch

Backstitch (top side)



Keep stitches evenly spaced. The bevel of the needle should face in the direction you are stitching.

Satin stitch (top side)



Keep the space between the stitches wide <up to approx. 5 mm (1/4 inch)>. For this stitch, make your stitches in a zigzag pattern, with the bevel of the needle facing in the same direction as the stopper in the illustration.

Loop/Velvet-like

Work backstitches from the back of the fabric. Reverse your design and draw it on the back side of the fabric.

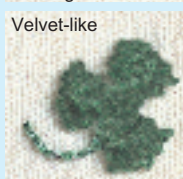


Keep your stitches equally spaced from the outside to the inside of the design, facing the bevel of the needle in the direction you are stitching.

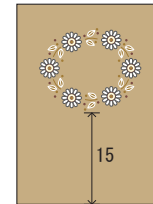


Turning the fabric

Procedure



【Main body】
 Outer fabric (Right side)

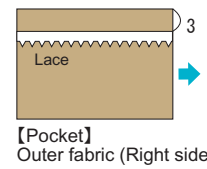


1. First, make the main body.
 Transfer the embroidery pattern onto the main-body outer fabric, with the bottom of the pattern located at 15 cm from the lower edge of the fabric, and do embroidery as shown in the illustration.
 Do not transcribe the outlines of flower petals (shown as dotted lines on the pattern).

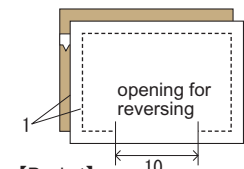
Stitch the center of a flower first, and then make loop-stitches with a ribbon for the portion of flower petals.

2. Then, make a pocket.

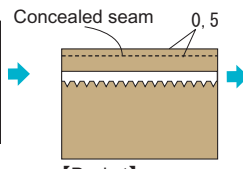
Sew some lace onto the front of the outer fabric of a pocket.
 Put together the pocket outer and lining fabrics wrong side out, and stitch them together leaving an opening for reversing. Once the fabrics are stitched together, reverse them right side out and blind stitch the opening.

 Outer fabric (Right side)



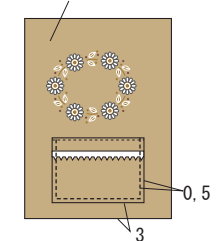
【Pocket】
 Outer fabric (Wrong side)



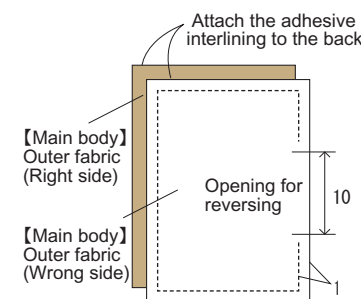
【Pocket】

3. Sew the pocket onto the main body.

 Outer fabric (Right side)

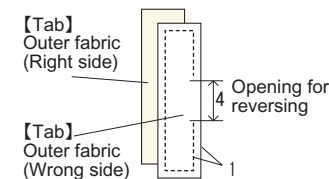


4. Put together the main-body outer and lining fabrics with an adhesive interlining on each back wrong side out, and stitch them together leaving an opening for reversing. Once the fabrics are stitched together, reverse them right side out and blind stitch the opening.

5. Make tabs.
 Put together the outer and backing fabrics of a tab wrong side out, and stitch them together leaving an opening for reversing. Once the fabrics are stitched together, reverse them right side out and blind stitch the opening. Make two of these.

6. Sew the tabs onto the main body.
 As shown in the illustration, sandwich the main body with folded tabs and sew buttons to fix it.
